Project Overview:

The research project aimed to investigate the prevalence and correlates of undernutrition among children aged 3–9 years residing in slum areas of Bhubaneswar, Odisha. Undernutrition poses a significant threat to the health and development of children, particularly in economically disadvantaged urban areas. The study sought to identify key factors contributing to undernutrition and propose targeted interventions for improvement.

Objectives:

Assess the prevalence of undernutrition among children aged 3–9 years in slum areas of Bhubaneswar.

Identify socio-economic, environmental, and dietary correlates associated with undernutrition.

Data Analysis: Employed statistical tools such as regression analysis to identify correlations and relationships between undernutrition and various factors.

Ethical Considerations: Ensured adherence to ethical guidelines in research involving human subjects, obtaining informed consent from participants, and maintaining confidentiality.

Key Findings:

High prevalence of undernutrition among children in slum areas.

Correlation between undernutrition and socio-economic factors, such as household income and parental education.

Influence of environmental factors, such as sanitation and access to clean water, on child nutrition.

Insight into dietary patterns and nutritional practices in slum communities.
